
CHAPTER 1**GENERAL PROVISIONS****115. PENALTIES**

Section 115.01. Penalty, Petty Misdemeanor. Whenever an act or omission is declared by this Code to be a petty offense or a petty misdemeanor, any person violating the provision shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.

Section 115.03. Penalty, Misdemeanors. In any other case, unless another penalty is expressly provided by this Code, any person violating any provision of this Code, or any rule or regulation adopted in pursuance thereof, or any other provision of any Code adopted in this Code by reference, or any provision of any license, special use permit, conditional use permit, condition or term of any approval, including any provision declaring an act or omission to be a misdemeanor, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$700 or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days, or both.

Section 115.05. Cost of Prosecution. In addition to the penalties provided for petty misdemeanors and misdemeanors, the cost of prosecution in either case may be added to the penalty.

Section 115.07. Separate Violations. Unless otherwise provided, each act of violation and every day on which a violation occurs or continuous constitutes a separate offense.

Section 115.09. Application to city Personnel. The failure of any officer or employee of the City to perform any official duty imposed by this Code shall not subject the officer or employee to the penalty imposed for violation unless a penalty is specifically provided for such failure.

Section 115.11. Invalidity. If any ordinance or a part thereof in the Medina City Code or any amendment thereafter enacted is held invalid or suspended, such invalidity or suspension shall not apply to any other part of the ordinance or any other ordinance unless it is specifically provided.

Section 115.13. Applicability. It is the intention of the Council that the penalties provided in this Code apply to the Code as adopted and any subsequent amendments thereto whether or not a penalty section is re-enacted in the amendatory ordinance.

Section 115.15. Permits and Licenses. Every violation of the terms, conditions or content of any permit, license or approval granted by the City Council or a city employee is a misdemeanor and shall constitute grounds for revocation of the permit, license or approval.
