Steering Committee Summary

Thursday, November 19, 2015



1. Steering Committee Chair Martin called the meeting to order at 8 a.m.
2. The Steering Committee reviewed the four draft visions provided. After discussion, the Steering Committee recommended the following Vision for the 2040 Comprehensive Plan:

“Medina is ONE community. The City will strive to maintain its unique heritage by promoting and protecting its rural character and its natural environment. Medina will foster well-designed neighborhoods and create retail and other destinations for the community to gather. The City will develop in a deliberate fashion as supported by school, transportation, water supply and wastewater infrastructure and in a manner that sustains residents through all stages of their lives.”
3. The Steering Committee reviewed the Comprehensive Plan Schedule. The Joint City Council/Planning Commission meeting was moved to Tuesday, December 15 and the next Steering Committee meeting will be on Wednesday, January 6 at 6:30 p.m.
4. The Steering Committee approved the October 29 and November 12 meeting summaries. The Steering Committee requested that the summaries continue with the same format.
