The male told her she could get her a refund but told her she would need to go out and purchase a \$100 iTunes card. The male told her that she would get refunded for the iTunes card along with her disputed charges of \$35 and an inconvenience fee of \$50 for a total refund of \$185. The male told her she would have to go immediately to the store and purchase the iTunes card and that she needed to her to keep him on the line while she went to the store. The victim said she went to the Medina Target and purchased the \$100 gift card and provided the male with the card number and PIN number for the card. The male told her the card did not go through and that she needed to purchase additional cards. She was then told to purchase four \$50 cards. She went to Walgreens in Plymouth and purchased four \$50 cards. She said she was then put on hold. While on hold she said her boyfriend found a phone number for iTunes and contacted them and was told she was being scammed. She tried to cancel the iTunes cards but was told they had already been redeemed.
