

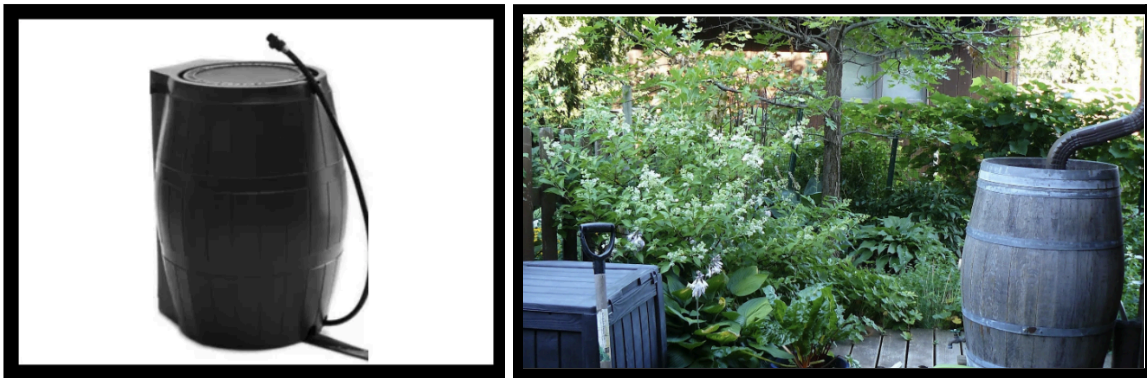


RAIN BARREL SALE

Rain barrels capture water from roof tops and hold it for later use in watering lawns, gardens or indoor plants. Capturing water prevents it from flowing off your property and polluting our watershed.

Long Lake Waters Association (LLWA) is excited to be able to offer rain barrels for sale in partnership with Harrison's Bay Association through the [Recycling Association of Minnesota](#).

These rain barrels are available to residents in Long Lake, Orono and Medina, and will be distributed for pick up on May 4th in Mound, Minnesota.



Why Rain Barrels - Storm water run-off is a significant cause of pollution in urban lakes and rivers. Using rain barrels to water your garden reduces runoff of the polluted water which carries phosphorus and sediment into the streams and lakes of our watershed. By using rain barrels, you can help protect the seven lakes, wetlands and streams in the Long Lake Creek Watershed!

Based on strong interest, we expect these rain barrels to sell out quickly. The rain barrels retail at \$120 and are being offered through the Recycling Association of MN for 25% off, or \$90 +tax.
